From the Gospel according to JOHN 2:13-22

'My Father's House Vs Market Place'!!!

Today we celebrate the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. In the first reading from The Book of Ezekiel we have the vision of 'waters of life' that flows from the sanctuary of the Temple. Sanctuary is the source of life. This water flows like a river and on the banks, we have fruit trees of every kind. Its fruits serve for food and the leaves for medicine. As it merges into the sea, it makes the salt water fresh! The Temple/ Sanctuary is the source of life.

In the second reading, St. Paul makes it clear that we are the temple of God and the Holy Spirit dwells within us. As the temple of God, we are Holy.

In the Gospel Jesus is trying to differentiate between the Father's House and a marketplace. In the marketplace the mode of activity is buying. The general nature of any marketplace or mart would be: 'what can I buy', 'what would be my profit' etc. Whereas, in a 'house', the family members would be competing as to 'what/ how much more can I give?' In a house the mode of activity is giving. The house/ family is based on love. Love is the base of giving in the house and so there is no question of gain or profit in the house. The peak point of this giving out of love, is self giving/ self emptying.

Jesus is claiming that His body is a house. It is full of love and is engaged in the activity of giving. The peak of His giving is the Cross: giving Himself completely for us. He is ready to sacrifice His body for love of us.

By the very act of cleaning the Jerusalem temple, Jesus is inviting every one of us to clean ourselves. We have to examine ourselves: 'What is the mode of our activities: profit or giving?' What is the mode of our spirituality: that of a marketplace or of a house? We must return from the marketplace-spirituality to a

spirituality of Father's House; where there is only giving out of love.

As Jesus did, and as St. Paul teaches us, let us keep our bodies as the Temple of God, dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. Let us try our best to give (out of love) not expecting anything in return. So that, the Loving God may reward us in abundance!

God may dwell in us all, Amen
