# **EPIPHANY Mt 2:1-12**

The word Epiphany means the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles as represented by the Magi. As today we celebrate the Epiphany of Christ, let us meditate on the responses of two groups of people to this manifestation of Christ.

The response of the high-ranking priests and the scribes. They knew everything of their religion and the Old Testament in detail. Quoting the Prophets they gave correct answer about the place of birth of Christ. Unfortunately this knowledge was the end in itself for them. It didn't do any good to their lives. They always remained in the palace.

We also know a lot of things about the Bible, the Church and of our Faith. Knowledge is a matter of brain or intellect. Do our knowledge move our hearts? Do they change our way of life?

The response of the Wise Men from the East. First of all they were seekers of the Divine. Bible says "they asked" Herod about the newborn king. We should be seekers of the Divine in and around us. We should raise questions and explore the resources around us to reach to God.

Mt 2:11 " they knelt and worshipped Him." Worship is the center of any religion in the world. How did these wise men worship Christ? By presenting the gifts of gold, incense and myrrh. These were very costly gifts. Thus, 'worship' for the Magi meant 'sacrifice.' we are here to worship; but what do you plan to sacrifice? Void of sacrifice, there is no true worship.

After their worship they went back their home country by 'another way.' True Worship should change our way of life. We cannot go back from this church as the same persons that walked in. Every worship is Epiphany, meeting with God. This meeting should change our lives.

Watch out for Epiphany around you as the Wise Men did. God may be appearing in front of us in the forms of needy brethren. May every one of those encounters be the true worship of sacrifice and may change our lives every time.

God may appear to you and Bless you all.
