

From the Gospel according to LUKE 13:22-30

Want to go to heaven? 'Take an Extra Effort.'

In today's Gospel Jesus is teaching us 'strive to enter through the 'narrow gate,' in order to enter into heaven. And he adds 'but many will not be strong enough.' Do you remember each and every member of our parish? We know that it is not that easy. But at the same time we may be remembering certain individual persons. Just because they might have been coordinating different ministries in the community. It is quite natural to remember anyone who ever takes an extra effort! If you take an extra effort to go to heaven then the Lord would remember you.

To enter through such a narrow gate we must be thin. We cannot try to enter through a narrow gate with a fatty body. In Lk 18:18 An official is asking Jesus: "what must I do to inherit eternal life?" In Lk 18:22 Jesus replied: "There is still one thing left for you: sell all that you have and distribute it to the poor, and you will have a treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." In order to become slim, we have to sell everything we have. We have to get rid of all our possessions.

In order to keep ourselves slim and not to add to our body mass we should be keeping distance from this worldly things! In the Gospel of Matthew 23:8-12 we hear Jesus telling us that you do not be called Rabbi, nor father, nor Master etc. This means that we should not let ourselves be addressed as someone having authority or power over others. If we would like to enter through that narrow gate, then we should humble ourselves to be a servant for others.

To enter through the narrow gate, we should become slim. What are all the ways to become slim? Sell off whatever we have, keep distance from disgraceful things and people, and moreover, make some extra effort so that the Lord may remember us!

Once a devotee approached the Lord Buddha to worship him with flowers in both hands. Buddha then, told the devotee to "put down." He put down the flowers in his left hand. Buddha repeated the same, and now the devotee put down the flowers in his right hand. For a third time Buddha said, "put down." Now the confused devotee asked Budha, "Lord, what shall I put down?" Budha replied, "Put down the one carrying the flower!" Yes, in order to go to heaven, we have to empty ourselves.

God may lead us through that narrow gate! Amen
