Sunday Reflection – Gospel: Mark 1: 12-15 By Maryanne Cardoz-Mascarenhas

JESUS said, "The time has come, the kingdom of God is at hand. Change your ways and believe the Good News."

Prior to preaching the Good News, Christ was in the wilderness being tempted. "He was with the wild animals, but angels ministered to him."
