

From the Gospel according to LUKE 14:7-14

BEAUTY OF SELF EMPTYING

Is there anyone among us who doesn't want to go to heaven? Last week we meditated on the concept: "Take an extra effort," in order that the Lord may remember us and open the narrow gate of heaven for us.

Today's first reading from Sirach 3:17-29 helps us to continue the same meditation. To go to heaven, we should find favor with God. Here we read: "Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God." And this first reading concludes by saying: "Alms atone for sins." If we are searching for the easiest shortcuts to heaven, then it would be self-emptying and alms giving!

Coming to the Gospel of the day, Luke 14:7-14, Jesus is telling us a parable. First, take care not to be confused as to, whether Jesus was speaking about a real thing, that was happening at that time. He was not, but instead he was telling a 'parable'/ a story!!! In that story, told by Jesus, the 'wedding banquet' represents our own lives. And now the question would be who we should invite and treat the most as our guests. Hospitality is seeing God in the stranger and welcoming him as our esteemed guest. To this end, Jesus is telling us that 'we have to humble ourselves in order to lift up someone else.' We should give up our seats to uplift the self-esteem of a poor person. We should be uplifting the lowly who otherwise will not come to the front.

It is interesting to note what would happen if we do not humble ourselves. Mt 23:12 "All who exalt themselves will be humbled." If we don't humble ourselves, we may not be favored by God. James 4:6 "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." Job 22:29 "For God abases the proud, but he saves the lowly."

St Paul in his letter to Philippians 2:6-8 speaks about self-emptying of Son of God. He says, though Jesus existed in the form of God, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, assuming human likeness.... The Greek word used here is 'KENOSIS' means Self Emptying! This kenosis is our way to go to heaven. May the Lord Jesus, who emptied himself, help us to humble ourselves in order to uplift someone else and thereby we may inherit the eternal life!
